Participants must be members of the Fremont Art Association and locations must be in the Tri City area of Fremont, Newark and Union City.

Categories

Artwork eligible for Open Studios should fall within the following categories:

- Painting (oil^a, watercolor^b, acrylic^c), mixed media^d, photography^e, computer art^f, ceramics^g, glass^h, sculptureⁱ, jewelry^k, fiber art^l, works on paper^m. (Please use superscripted codes in application for use in the map.)
- No crafts

Deadline

Fees and signed application form must be received by March 15th, 2010.

Entry Fees

\$40 for the first individual artist
\$40 for each additional artist at the same location
Make checks payable to the Fremont Art Association.

We encourage individual artists to group together at one location. Sites with multiple artists often have higher attendance from those locations with only one artist.

Fees Cover

- Color postcards with an image of one of the location artists' work and a list of each location. To minimize our impact on the environment, request only the amount of cards you need.
- Print out of locations and map (also will be available as a pdf on www.fremontartassociation.org)
- 1 yard poster with stake
- Publicity: artist newsletters, calendar listings, and local newspapers

Each Participant is Responsible For

- Mailing postcards
- His/her own sales and collection of the proper sales taxes
- Refreshments (recommended)
- Each site is responsible for placing a poster in at least one location in the area
- Providing your one selected jpeg image, 300 dpi, for your location to Pamela Bevans by March 15th for the postcard: pamelabevans@comcast.net
Please include your name as the title of the image. Because of the large amount of participating artists only one image per location will be accepted to be used on the postcard.
- If your location desires, you may conduct a door prize/raffle at your own location consisting of items donated by the artists represented there. There will be no general FAA contest for the most sites visited this year.
